KEYNOTE SPEAKER

He received his B.A. from Duke University, his M.Div. from Candler School of Theology, and his Ph.D. from Emory University. He taught for fifteen years in theological education at Emory University and Bangor Theological Seminary, during which time he published books and articles on practical theology and was a visiting scholar at Cambridge University's Psychology and Religion project. In 2007 he joined the faculty at Husson University where he teaches and writes about ethics, philosophy, moral psychology, and religion. He has lead professional ethics trainings throughout Maine for social workers, counselors, nurses, and tax assessors.
