

**Community Benefit Report
FY 2012, October 2011 – March 2012**

Acadia Hospital Total Benefit: \$ 5,941,030

Community Impact: Acadia Hospital continues to be guided by the 2010 Community Health Needs Assessment as it works to connect with other mental health and substance abuse providers throughout Maine. During the past year, Acadia also responded to the developing Bath Salts crisis by partnering with other agencies to provide extensive educational outreach on the topic. The hospital's Open Mind series offered a public presentation on depression and the use of Electroconvulsive Therapy (ECT) in Bangor, as well as a talk on the Wisdom of the Aging Brain in Blue Hill. The hospital's Artisan Project offered a permanent exhibit space for artwork created by clients. Additionally, Acadia continued its focus on youth wellness by partnering with the National Tourette Syndrome Association to offer a series of educational sessions to multiple target audiences in May. Finally, the hospital completed its most ambitious public education project to date by producing and premiering a short dramatic film on youth anxiety and depression called, The Road Back. Made in conjunction with Project AWARE, the film, created by area teens, was screened in front of a sold-out audience at Gracie Theatre in March, and has since been distributed free of charge to more than 100 middle and high schools in Maine.
