Smoking:

The use of tobacco products, including electronic cigarettes, is not permitted inside or outside of Acadia Hospital. Nicotine patches and gum are available once ordered by an Acadia provider.

Visitors/Calls:

Each unit has portable telephones available for use. You and/or your guardian must indicate in writing those people you wish to receive visits and calls from while at Acadia Hospital.

Information for Family/Visitors:

- For everyone’s safety, visitors will be greeted by Security upon arrival and asked if they have any unsafe items. All bags, including pocketbooks, and outerwear will be examined by Security and placed in a secure locker in the main lobby.
- Visitors are allowed to bring single serve factory sealed food items such as gum, hard candy, juice boxes or granola bars. No fast food or homemade food is allowed.
- For safety reasons, plastic bags, metal or glass items are not allowed in the patient care areas.
